Walking through the ravine Erlenbach

Please join me for an unforgettable walk down the ravine and the geological nature trail of Erlenbach. After taking bus 691 from Erlenbach station to Trottgatter, we take a short walk along Forchstrasse to the beginning of the trail for the ravine. Descending downhill for 60 - 75 minutes (not too steeply), be sure to take your walking sticks if needed and good walking shoes with a good profile to safely reach the destination of Erlenbach village. Also remember to take a drinking bottle along, wearing adequate clothing, all depending on the current weather.

There are quite a few small bridges crossing the brook and even more numerous small waterfalls, making this excursion a unique one. On the way are descriptions with photographs about how to keep a large diversity of plants in regularly cutting certain shrubs and bushes within the forest area.

To keep in mind:

Meeting point: 17.45 h Erlenbach ZH, Bahnhof, at Bus stop 691 (on the lake-side of the building of the train station). Departure from there is with bus 691 at 18.03 h to bus stop "Trottgatter", arr. 18.12 h. Everyone gets his/her own ticket

→ Buy a return ticket to Erlenbach ZH, Trottgatter. Recommended train ride from Zürich HB is: S16 dep. HB at 17.30 h, arr. Erlenbach at 17.45 h. When registering, please write if you come to a nearby Swiss restaurant after the hike, leaving your full name and phone number.



Can you remember? So many decades ago? You were a pupil and it was afternoon and your school class went into the gymnastic hall (Turnhalle). What did you encounter there for sure? YES, the so called «Turngeräteböcke», manufactured by Alder & Eisenhut. Each of us used to do gymnastics on this equipment.

This afternoon, let's travel back to this good old times. Because Alder & Eisenhut in Ebnat-Kappel (Toggenburg) still exists and also hosts a museum with lots of history in it.

The afternoon programme looks as followed:

- 14.24 h 15.39 h train ride from Zurich HB to Ebnat Kappel
- 300 meters walk from the railway station to the museum
- 16.00 h: German guided 1h tour in the Turngerätemuseum of Alder & Eisenhut in Ebnat-Kappel

At 17.15 h straight from the museum, we have a flat and non strenuous walk down to Wattwil, always along the Thur River with

splendid views to the mountains (i.e. Churfirsten, Speer). Duration, approx. 75 minutes. Please take sun protection and plenty of water with you.

- 18.30 h Dinner in a good restaurant near Bahnhof in Wattwil.
- afterwards: every 30 minutes good connections back to Zurich.

Members pay CHF 5.00 and guests CHF 10.00 for the guided tour. Also suitable for car drivers, plenty of parking space at the museum

In case of bad weather, extreme heat or risk of thunderstorms, we cancel the walk and proceed towards Wattwil by public transport. There is a very dense network with Bus, Postauto and SOB train. Please buy your own return ticket Zurich HB – Ebnat-Kappel, a so-called **Z-Pass Ostwind-ZVV Tageskarte** for CHF 29.00 with ½ Tax Abo. The recommended route itinerary is via Uster – Rapperswil - Uznach – Wattwil.
