

Mammut Museum Niederweningen



What would you do if you went out for an evening stroll and all of a sudden, a huge mammut bull would come out of the forest? No worries, they don't exist anymore (you rather encounter a wolf, a lynx or even a hungry bear...). But approx. 24'000 years ago, it is a matter of fact that mammuts lived in our latitudes. In 1890, parts of a mammut skeleton were found in the Wehntal, and this was a national sensation – and later also the inspiration in order to build up the "Mammutmuseum" in Niederweningen. Together with Mrs. Andrea Weber, we will have a German guided tour for 1 hour while travelling back into the last ice age when those huge "guys" were alive. Costs for members: CHF 5.00, guests pay CHF 15.00. How to get there: Buy a return ticket to "Niederweningen <u>Dorf"</u> which can be reached from Zurich HB by the S 15 train (direct train). It is a 5-minute

walk to the museum. After the tour, we can go to the Restaurant Löwen for food and drink, just next to the railway station.

For car drivers, there is parking space, please adjust your "Navi" to Mitteldorfstrasse 1, 8166 Niderweningen.

Meeting point: Meet Jürg at 16.05 h at track 12 at Zurich HB, we will take S15 leaving 16.22 h, arr. 16.53 h.

The tour starts at 17.00 h.

Maggi Museum Singen & Christmas Market at Rathausplatz

Santa Claus Day – BRRR !!! - But can you remember? It was on a hot summer day in 2024 when we went to visit the former Maggi Areal in Kemptthal. This time, we go to the birth place of Maggi in Singen (DE) on a probably **cold** winter day, combined with the nearby Christmas Market at Rathausplatz.

The itinerary looks as followed:

Market.

08.50 h meet at track 14 in Zürich HB.

Train ride to Singen (Hohentwiel) HB 09.05 h departs, Singen 10.15 h arrives, change train in Schaffhausen. 10.30 h guided tour with Mrs. Maria Jörke in the Maggi manufacture Singen, next to the railway station. Partly performed in English, special expressions will be explained in German, duration: approx.1 ½ hour. Costs: FREE of charge for members, guests pay CHF 5.00. After the tour, we have a 15-minute walk towards Rathausplatz where we have a various food offer for lunch at good rates in €. From there, we enjoy stunning views to the massive fortification Hohentwiel which dominates Singen. Hohentwiel is a former volcano which can also be seen from the Zurich area on a clear day. We eat outside while standing but some sitting benches + tables are available. Dress yourself accordingly to cold temperatures and airdraft. If someone wants to be inside for lunch, there is a Spanish restaurant just next to the Christmas

Travelling back can be done individually. Don't choose a fast or direct train (ICE from Stuttgart) to Zurich HB (high surcharge for a very short distance).

The purchase of the best international railway ticket is a very tricky affair. Please buy a return ticket to Schaffhausen ONLY. Costs: CHF 24.20 with ½ Tax Abo. I will be the one to purchase the remaining section Schaffhausen – Singen directly with a separate ticket (a so called OTV-VHB Kombi Tageskarte, costs CHF10.80 with ½ Tax Abo). So, the total cost for the train ride ends up with CHF 35.00. As you know, the Deutsche Bahn (DB) is not as reliable as SBB. Should severe problems occur with the train ride between Schaffhausen and Singen (delay, cancelled trains), we have car drivers who will bring "stranded" members back to the right place.
